CERTIFICATION

The Colonial Newfoundland Club, Inc. has been granted permission to hold its annual Water Test by the Working Dog Committee of the Newfoundland Club of America.

Rules and Regulations

This water test will be conducted in accordance with the NCA Regulations governing Water Tests. Exhibitors are responsible for knowing the regulations. Test regulations can be downloaded from the NCA website (www.ncanews.org) or obtained for \$5.00 by writing to the Working Dog Committee Publications Secretary, Dwight Gorsuch, 6282 Burris Road, Rock Hall, MD 21661.

The Test Site

Codorus State Park is located three miles southeast of Hanover, PA. The beach area is composed of thin, generally round rocks, about 3" in diameter. The water is clear and, with the rocky bottom, very little silt is stirred up for the underwater retrieve. Dogs are swimming within 20 feet of shore. Since there is very little natural shade in the area, exhibitors and spectators should plan to bring their own shade (umbrellas or tents) for themselves and their dogs.

Entries

The entry fee for WD, WRD, WRDX divisions and re-qualification is \$40.00. Send entry fees for the **WD, WRD** and **WRDX** tests (payable to CNC), a completed entry form and a copy of your dog's registration to: Cindy Flowers, CNC Water Test Secretary, 19894 Telegraph Springs Road, Purcellville, VA 20132. All entries that provide an email address will be notified by email of their entry receipt.

Entry Limitations

Entries for the WRDX test on Friday are limited to a total of 12 entries. Entries for the Saturday and Sunday WD and WRD tests are limited to a total of 22 on Saturday and Sunday regardless of division entered. All entries will be accepted beginning with postmarks on July 14, 2009. Entries close at the Test Secretary's home at 5:00 p.m. on August 14, 2009.

Requalifiers

Entries for requalification will be accepted only if the entry limit is not reached. Dogs that qualify at a previous test may stay in as Requalifiers, but will be moved to the alternate list (if any). Acceptance into the test(s) will then be based on postmark of the original entry.

Note: The NCA WDC has approved the eligibility of WRD-titled dogs to enter the Junior Division. These entries will be made on a space-available basis so as not to exclude untitled dogs. WRD-titled dogs entering Junior, whether they pass or not, may not post-enter the Senior Division on that day.

Post-Entries

Dogs that successfully fulfill the requirements for a Water Dog title at a test may be post-entered into the Senior Division at that test and will be tested at the conclusion of Senior Division judging. The handler will be allowed to test his dog only until it fails an exercise. An additional post-entry fee of \$15.00 must be given to the Test Secretary at the site at the completion of the Junior Division.

WRDX Fitness Certification

A dog must pass a qualifying fitness swim before exhibiting in a WRDX test. The handler must provide the test secretary with a copy of the dog's fitness certification before competing with the dog in a test. The fitness certification must be issued within the water test season dated 2009. Read the Fitness Certification section of the WRDX rules for the testing procedure and certification process.

Bitches in Season

Bitches in season will not be allowed on the test site until just prior to being judged, which will be after ALL judging has been completed. As a courtesy, please inform the Test Secretary prior to August, 26 if your bitch will be in season.

Spectators and Unentered Dogs

Spectators, as well as unentered dogs (except bitches in season) are welcome at the CNC Water Test. However, unentered dogs will not be permitted in the test site area. As a courtesy to our exhibitors, we ask that all dogs be kept quiet and leashed or crated.

Hotel Accommodations

A block of rooms has been reserved at the Boston Inn in Westminster, MD. Please make your reservations early as this is a very busy weekend in the area, and any rooms not reserved by July 27 will be released. Following that date you may not be able to find local accommodations.

CNC Safety Policy

1) Dogs must be crated or on leash at all times. 2) When on leash, the length of the leash must not exceed six feet and may not be a retractable leash. 3) When on leash, dogs must be under control at all times. 4) Dogs showing uncontrolled or aggressive behavior will be asked by the event chair, a board member, or other official to leave the site promptly or to be crated for the duration of the event. 5) Failure to meet these conditions may result in a disciplinary hearing. There will be occasions when the dog will be allowed off lead when approved by the event chairman.

Directions to the Site

From Maryland & South – go to Frederick. Take Rt. 26 east and Md. 194 north to the Square in Hanover, PA. Turn right (south) onto Rt. 94. Go 3.9 miles. Turn left at light onto Grandview Dr. (Exxon station on left.) Go 1.8 miles and turn right onto Rt. 216 south. (go to **)

From Baltimore Beltway (695) – take exit 19 (I-795N). Go to the end of I-795 (last exit—toward Hampstead and Hanover). Cross Rt. 140 at light and proceed to Rt. 3-. Turn left on Rt. 30 (north). Proceed north into Pennsylvania. Turn right onto Grandview Dr. (at Exxon station and traffic light). Go 1.8 miles and turn right onto Rt. 216 south. (go to **)

From the Boston Inn – turn right out of the parking lot onto Rt. 140 east. Get in the left lane and make a U-turn at the next light (about .2 mile). Stay in the second lane from the right (to avoid exit lanes for other streets) for about 1 mile until you see signs for Rt. 27. Enter the right lane and take Rt. 27 North (right turn from ramp). Follow Rt. 27 North until it dead ends at a light (about 9 miles: there will be a Sheetz Gas and Convenience Store directly in front). Turn left onto Rt. 30 North (this is MD Rt. 30, not to be confused with PA Rt. 30!) MD Rt. 30 becomes PA 94 North at the state line. Go about 4.5 miles. Pass light at McDonald's. At next light turn right onto Grandview Road. Go through 4-way stop sign. At the next light turn right onto 216 (go to **)

** Take Rt. 216 for 3.3 miles. You will enter Codorus State Park.

Turn onto SR 3041 towards Jefferson. Go ½ mile and turn left (there will be a horse trailer parking sign on the right before the turn. Take the 1st right into the Sensheim parking lot in the boat launch parking area.

Addendum to the NCA Working Test Rules: Handling of Entries, Alternates and Refunds Effective: October 1, 2008

Accepting Entries

Test premiums will list an opening and closing date for entries. The opening date is the earliest date an entry can be sent as indicated by the postmark of the entry; the closing date is the last day an entry can be received by the test secretary and is unrelated to the postmark. The test will not close officially until the published closing date, even if the entries exceed the limit before the closing date. This overrides section 12 of the current water and draft test rules.

No dog will be allowed to enter more than one division in a test or on the same day, with the exception of post entries.

Do not assign final entries until the closing date. This will accommodate entries that arrive on different dates but that have identical postmarks. Open all envelopes before assigning entries, because some envelopes may contain more than one entry and some may be entering only one day of a two-day test weekend.

When the test closes, if the entries exceed the maximum limit, follow the procedure listed below. If a lottery is required as specified below, a separate lottery MUST be held for each of the two days of a two-day test weekend. (Note: An efficient and unbiased way to do a lottery is to number each entry and put the corresponding numbers on small, individual pieces of paper. Randomly select the papers to determine the status of each entry.) There must always be at least two people present to witness the lottery, at least one of which is not entered in the test.

Assigning Entries

1. Assign a spot in the test to each entry postmarked with the first allowed entry date; assign a spot in the test to each entry postmarked with the second allowed entry date; continue as above until all spots in the test are full.

2. If at any time there are more entries with identical postmarks than spots available in the test, conduct a lottery to determine which entries are accepted into the test. Those not assigned spots become alternates.

Example 1: If the entries received with the first allowed postmark exceed the test limit on the closing date, conduct a lottery with all of the entries with that postmark. Those not chosen become alternates. Continue to do a lottery for each postmarked date to determine the order of the alternate list.

Example 2: There are openings in the test for entries postmarked with the first and second allowed date. Five entries are postmarked with the third allowed date and there are two openings left. Conduct a lottery with those five entries—two will be entered in the test and three will become alternates as will any entries with later postmarks.

Example 3: If the limit is 25, and there are 30 entries with the first postmark, the first 25 randomly selected in the lottery will be assigned spots in the test and the remaining entries will be pulled as first alternate, second alternate, third alternate, etc. Assign other entries with later postmarks as alternates in the same way doing a lottery for each postmarked date.

3. Add requalification entries to the alternate list after all untitled dogs on the list. Requalification entries should be added by postmark and by lottery, as necessary.

Withdrawing Entries and Refunds

To withdraw an entry, the entrant must notify the test secretary by telephone, email, or U.S. mail. The secretary must confirm receipt of such notifications. The entrant will receive a full refund of the entry fee if the notification is received prior to the closing date for entries. After the closing date has passed, no refunds will be given, even if an alternate was tested in their place, with the exception of alternates that did not get into the test. In addition, an entrant with one dog in the test and another on the alternate list may not substitute one dog for the other. If the entrant must pull the entered dog, then the first dog on the alternate list will fill the opening.

Alternates and Refunds

If an entrant submits an entry to a draft or water test but is not assigned a place in the test; the test secretary must notify the entrant immediately after the closing date and give the entrant the option to be placed on the alternate list. If the entrant prefers not to be on the alternate list, he or she will receive a full refund. If the entrant chooses to stay on the alternate list and pulls their entry at a later date they will not receive a refund.

Once the closing date listed in the premium has passed, if an entrant notifies the secretary that they are withdrawing their entry or have passed at a previous test, all entrants on the alternate list must be notified that their ranks have changed. If a space does not become available for an alternate on or before the day of the test, the alternate will receive a full refund.

Example: If a test limit is 25 dogs and 25 dogs are tested, but none of the five dogs that were on an alternate list were tested, the five alternates would receive refunds after the test. If 20 original dogs and three alternates were tested, but two alternates did not attend the test, the handlers of those two alternates would not receive refunds because had they attended, they would have been tested.

If an entrant has been assigned a spot in the test but their dog passes at a previous test, the handler must notify the test secretary by 6 pm the night before the test as to whether they will move their entry to another division (i.e., WD to WRD or WRD to WRDX), withdraw from the test, or requalify in the same division if the test is not full. If the test is full they have the option of being moved to the end of the alternate list to requalify. This overrides Section 4.4.B. of the current water test rules.
