Saturday entries for the WRDX, WD and WRD tests are limited to a total of 25 entries with a limit of 5 WRDX entries. If all 5 Saturday WRDX slots are not filled, they may be used for WD and WRD entries.

Sunday entries for the WD and WRD tests are limited to a total of 25 entries.

Entries from within the United States will be accepted by U.S. Postal Service mail only and priority will be given to entrants who have not earned titles in the Division entered. Foreign entries must show a verifiable date of mailing.

Rules and Regulations

This water test will be conducted in accordance with the NCA
Regulations governing Water Tests. Exhibitors are responsible for knowing
the regulations. Test regulations can be downloaded from the NCA website
(www.ncanewfs.org) or obtained for \$5.00 by writing to the Working Dog
Committee Publications Secretary, Dwight Gorsuch, 6282 Burriss Road, Rock
Hall, MD 21661.

The Test Site – Original Location

Codorus State Park is located three miles southeast of Hanover, PA. The
beach area is composed of thin, generally round rocks, about 3" in diameter.
The water is clear and, with the rocky bottom, very little silt is stirred up for
the underwater retrieve. Dogs are swimming within 20 feet of shore. Since
there is very little natural shade in the area, exhibitors and spectators should
plan to bring their own shade (umbrellas or tents) for themselves and their
dogs.

Entries

The entry fee for WD, WRD, WRDX divisions and re-qualification is
\$40.00. Send entry fees for the **WD, WRD** and **WRDX** tests (payable to
CNC), a completed entry form and a copy of your dog's registration to: Cindy
Flowers 19894 Telegraph Springs Rd. Purcellville, VA 20132. All entries that
provide an email address will be notified by email of their entry receipt.

The new standard NCA entry form is attached. Please be sure to use a separate
entry form for each day and test which you are entering. In accordance with
NCA's updated regulations, be sure to indicate NCA membership of all co-
owners or handler on each entry form.

Entry Limitations

Entries for the WRDX, WRDX requal and WRD requal tests on **Friday**
are limited to a total of 10 entries, with up to five slots for WRDX and WRDX
requal. If all 5 are not filled with WRDX and WRDX requal entries, the
unused slots may be used for WRD Requals.

Entries for the **Saturday** WRDX, WD and WRD tests are limited to a total of
25 entries with a limit of 5 WRDX entries. If all 5 Saturday WRDX slots are
not filled, the unused spots may be used for WD and WRD entries.

Sunday WD and WRD entries are limited to a total of 25. Entries for NCA
members will be accepted beginning with postmarks on **June 15, 2017**.
Entries for non-NCA members will be accepted beginning with postmarks on
June 26, 2017. Entries close at the Test Secretary's home at 5:00 p.m. on **July
15, 2017**.

Note: All breed testing is not offered this year.

Requalifiers

Entries for requalification will be accepted only if the entry limit is not
reached. Dogs that qualify at a previous test may stay in as Requalifiers, but
will be moved to the alternate list (if any). Acceptance into the test(s) will
then be based on postmark of the original entry.

Note: The NCA WDC has approved the eligibility of WRD-titled dogs
to enter the Junior Division. These entries will be made on a space-available
basis so as not to exclude untitled dogs. WRD-titled dogs entering Junior,
whether they pass or not, may not post-enter the Senior Division on that day.

WRDX requalifiers on Saturday: If WRDX slots do not fill with
untitled WRDX entries, those slots would have to be filled with untitled
WD/WRD entries before testing WRDX requalifiers.

Requalifications as Multiple Division Entries

Multiple Division requalifications will be allowed at NCA Water Tests.
Dogs may be entered in more than one division on the same day but only if
they have already qualified, at previous tests, in all of the divisions entered.
Each entry must be sent on a separate entry form. If the entry for the test
exceeds its limit and a lottery is necessary, the dog may not get into each
division entered. There will be no substitutions for dogs to change divisions if
their entry is chosen for one division but not the other in a lottery. Judges must
excuse any dog not in condition to finish the division entered and, if so, the
dog will not be able to continue in any other division entered that day. Entry
fees will not be refunded for dogs that are excused. Entrants are discouraged
from pushing their dogs beyond their limits.

Post-Entries

Dogs that successfully fulfill the requirements for a Water Dog title at a test may be post-entered into the Senior Division at that test and will be tested at the conclusion of Senior Division judging. The handler will be allowed to test his dog only until it fails an exercise. An additional post-entry fee of \$20.00 must be given to the Test Secretary at the site at the completion of the Junior Division.

Titles to be used on NCA working event entry forms, catalogs and certificates

The NCA Board has voted to only recognize NCA, AKC and verifiable CKC titles for NCA events. Any other titles will not be listed in the catalog or on the title certificates.

WRDX Fitness Certification – Not Required

Though a fitness certification is no longer required, it is a handler's responsibility to prepare and condition his or her dog physically for the extreme distance and time required to complete these exercises. It is the judges' responsibility to terminate any exercise at any time a dog is deemed to be in distress or appears to be experiencing difficulty in completing any of the exercises. The exercise will be stopped immediately and the dog will be excused from further testing.

Bitches in Season

Bitches in season will not be allowed on the test site until just prior to being judged, which will be after ALL judging has been completed. As a courtesy, please inform the Test Secretary prior to July 25th if your bitch will be in season.

Spectators and Unentered Dogs

Spectators, as well as unentered dogs (except bitches in season) are welcome at the CNC Water Test. However, unentered dogs will not be permitted in the test site area. As a courtesy to our exhibitors, we ask that all dogs be kept quiet and leashed or crated.

Hotel Accommodations

A block of rooms has been reserved at the Best Western in Westminster, MD under "Colonial Newfoundland Club". Please make your reservations early as this is a very busy weekend in the area, and any rooms not reserved by July 3 will be released. Following that date you may not be able to find local accommodations. The room rate is \$94 (Thurs) and \$107 (Fri/Sat). There is also a \$15 pet fee. No wet dogs allowed in hotel rooms!

CNC Safety Policy

1) Dogs must be crated or on leash at all times. 2) When on leash, the length of the leash must not exceed six feet and may not be a retractable leash. 3) When on leash, dogs must be under control at all times. 4) Dogs showing uncontrolled or aggressive behavior will be asked by the event chair, a board member, or other official to leave the site promptly or to be crated for the duration of the event. 5) Failure to meet these conditions may result in a disciplinary hearing. There will be occasions when the dog will be allowed off lead when approved by the event chairman.

From Maryland & South – go to Frederick. Take Rt. 26 east and Md. 194 north to the Square in Hanover, PA. Turn right (south) onto Rt. 94. Go 3.9 miles. Turn left at light onto Grandview Dr. (Exxon station on left.) Go 1.8 miles and turn right onto Rt. 216 south. (go to **)

From Baltimore Beltway (695) – take exit 19 (I-795N). Go to the end of I-795 (last exit—toward Hampstead and Hanover). Cross Rt. 140 at light and proceed to Rt. 3-. Turn left on Rt. 30 (north). Proceed north into Pennsylvania. Turn right onto Grandview Dr. (at Exxon station and traffic light). Go 1.8 miles and turn right onto Rt. 216 south. (go to **)

From the Best Western – Turn right onto Taneytown Pike. Take MD-97N exit toward Penn Ave/Westminster. Turn Left onto Penn Ave (signs for Gettysburg/MD-97N). Continue onto MD 97N/Littlestown Pike. Addendum to the NCA Working Test Rules: Handling of Entries, Alternates and Refunds Effective: October 1, 2008

Accepting Entries

Test premiums will list an opening and closing date for entries. The opening date is the earliest date an entry can be sent as indicated by the postmark of the entry; the closing date is the last day an entry can be received by the test secretary and is unrelated to the postmark. The test will not close officially until the published closing date, even if the entries exceed the limit before the closing date. This overrides section 12 of the current water and draft test rules.

No dog will be allowed to enter more than one division in a test or on the same day, with the exception of post entries and multiple division requalifications.

Do not assign final entries until the closing date. This will accommodate entries that arrive on different dates but that have identical postmarks. Open all envelopes before assigning entries, because some envelopes may contain more than one entry and some may be entering only one day of a two-day test weekend.

When the test closes, if the entries exceed the maximum limit, follow the procedure listed below. If a lottery is required as specified below, a separate lottery **MUST** be held for each of the two days of a two-day test weekend. (Note: An efficient and unbiased way to do a lottery is to number each entry and put the corresponding numbers on small, individual pieces of paper. Randomly select the papers to determine the status of each entry.) There must always be at least two people present to witness the lottery, at least one of which is not entered in the test.

Assigning Entries*-- Revised 2015

1. Assign a spot in the test to each entry postmarked with the first allowed entry date; assign a spot in the test to each entry postmarked with the second allowed entry date; continue as above until all spots in the test are full. **Note: NCA members will be given 10-day advance window to enter.*

2. If at any time there are more entries with identical postmarks than spots available in the test, conduct a lottery to determine which entries are accepted into the test. Those not assigned spots become alternates.

Example 1: If the entries received with the first allowed postmark exceed the test limit on the closing date, conduct a lottery with all of the entries with that postmark. Those not chosen become alternates. Continue to do a lottery for each postmarked date to determine the order of the alternate list.

Example 2: There are openings in the test for entries postmarked with the first and second allowed date. Five entries are postmarked with the third allowed date and there are two openings left. Conduct a lottery with those five entries—two will be entered in the test and three will become alternates as will any entries with later postmarks.

Example 3: If the limit is 25, and there are 30 entries with the first postmark, the first 25 randomly selected in the lottery will be assigned spots in the test and the remaining entries will be pulled as first alternate, second alternate, third alternate, etc. Assign other entries with later postmarks as alternates in the same way doing a lottery for each postmarked date.

3. Add requalification entries to the alternate list after all untitled dogs on the list. Requalification entries should be added by postmark and by lottery, as necessary.

Alternates and Refunds

If an entrant submits an entry to a draft or water test but is not assigned a place in the test; the test secretary must notify the entrant immediately after the closing date and give the entrant the option to be placed on the alternate list. If the entrant prefers not to be on the alternate list, he or she will receive a full refund. If the entrant chooses to stay on the alternate list and pulls their entry at a later date they will not receive a refund.

Once the closing date listed in the premium has passed, if an entrant notifies the secretary that they are withdrawing their entry or have passed at a previous test, all entrants on the alternate list must be notified that their ranks have changed. If a space does not become available for an alternate on or before the day of the test, the alternate will receive a full refund.

Example: If a test limit is 25 dogs and 25 dogs are tested, but none of the five dogs that were on an alternate list were tested, the five alternates would receive refunds after the test. If 20 original dogs and three alternates were tested, but two alternates did not attend the test, the handlers of those two alternates would not receive refunds.

Change in “Basic Control” Requirements for 2015

All (and only) WD entrants will be required to perform individual basic control exercises prior to being tested-- on the beach facing the test area. This requirement applies to WD entrants who have earned a Companion Dog obedience title. There will be no Group Down. Please review new requirements for Basic Control at www.ncanewfs.org under Water Test regulations.
